Can you help?

Detectives from North West Leicestershire CID are appealing for information after a man was stabbed in woods near Oakthorpe.

The victim, a man in his 20's was walking in the Willesley Wood area at around 6pm on Sunday 21st August when he was followed by a group of 8 to 10 men.

The victim told police he was asked for the time before one of the group slashed the top of his head with a knife. He then suffered a minor puncture wound to the abdomen.

The victim was also punched, knocking him unconscious. The group had left the woods by the time he had regained consciousness.

While no arrests have been made at this time, our enquiries are continuing and anyone who believes they may be able to help please get in touch.
