TWO PEOPLE CHARGED WITH STABBING IN MOIRA

Two people have been charged after a woman was stabbed in Moira.

This is a highly unusual event and inevitably caused concern within a small community. A significant number of officers and staffed mounted an excellent response to what was a very confusing initial set of information. The victim was quickly identified and taken to hospital, to be treated for multiple stab-wounds, including to the chest. Thankfully the victim's injuries were ultimately not life-threatening and they will make a largely full recovery from what was a traumatising attack. Within 24 hours some excellent patrol and response policing by staff from North West Leicestershire NPA resulted in two suspects being located and arrested.

Amy Redfern, 27, of Sweet Hill, Moira charged with attempted murder and three counts of possessing a knife blade/sharp pointed article in a public place.

Filipe Dix, 27, of Stanley Road, Nuneaton has been charged with assisting an offender.

Both have been remanded into custody to appear before Leicester Magistrates' Court on Friday 6th May.

ACRESFORD

04/05/2022 – Winfield's Store - Store supervisor reporting theft from store of 2 coats and another item stolen. Enquiries ongoing – Crime reference 22*252532.

ALBERT VILLAGE

04/05/2022 – Main Street – Electrical fault transformer fire, Police, Fire and Western Power attended.

Dog on Dog attack at Albert Village Lake – enquiries on-going – Crime number 22*293530. Regular patrols around the lake are taking place.

APPLEBY MAGNA

03/05/2022 – Anti-social behaviour with dogs trespassing on property and fouling.

11/05/2022 – Appleby Inn Hotel – Taxi driver drops off male who refuses to pay.

13/05/2022 – Reports of males flagging down vehicles and trying to sell gold for money for fuel.

15/05/2022 - Macdonalds Restaurant - Victim reports theft of her mobile phone in McDonalds - no known CCTV, no known witnesses, no descriptions provided and no named suspects





15/05/2022 – A444 – Report from EMAS regarding male found unconscious at the side of the road, Police attended and male was taken to hospital.

19/05/2022 – Shell Garage – reports of 5-6 males being abusive to a taxi driver and refusing to pay, males had left when police attended.

BLACKFORDBY

02/05/2022 – Main Street – Section 165 issued – vehicle recovered.

DONISTHORPE

06/05/2022 – Moira Road – RTC involving car and dog. Dog ran into the road and driver did not have time to stop, dog ran off afterwards and owner's details were obtained. No injuries to driver or dog reported.

13/05/2022 – Resident had a male knock on his door and ask him if he would sell his vehicle.

18/05/2022 - Unknown suspect let the air out of a vehicle tyre causing damage to the valve.

16/05/2022 - Man has been pushed around his neck following argument at air BNB premises

MEASHAM

Anti-social behaviour reported at Bosworth Skate Park, regular patrols are taking place and an Anti-social behaviour report has been created – Sentinel number 132988.

03/05/2022 – Internal door was damaged while occupant out - no witnesses or CCTV.

03/05/2022 – Measham Leisure Centre – Unauthorised encampment - Report of a single caravan and two vehicles parked up at the Leisure Centre – Police attended and vehicles were removed.

07/05/2022 – Burton Road Bus Stop – Anti-social behaviour – youths causing a nuisance – area search by officers with no trace. Beat Officers to conduct regular patrols. Sentinel report 132991.

07/05/2022 – Greenfield Road – reports of males driving slowly in vehicle – area search by officers with no trace.





07/05/2022 – Sweptstone Road - Single vehicle had crashed into a tree and driver had fled the scene prior to police arrival - How the collision occurred: Vehicle has tried overtaking another vehicle on a single carriageway when approaching a blind corner. Vehicle then swerved back into the lane and has collided with a tree on the nearside of the vehicle and come to a stop 20 meters down on from where collision with tree has occurred. Driver traced – no injuries to report.

09/05/2022 – Male arrived at address to collect items as advertised. Upon his arrival he was told that the items had already been sold to which he became angry and abusive, he then apologised and left.

11/05/2022 – Burton Road – Broken down vehicle on a dangerous bend. Police attended and managed the traffic until the vehicle was recovered.

13/05/2022 – Resident reports that 4- 5 youths aged 14-15 years tried to enter her property by opening the front door, when approached by the resident they ran away.

13/05/2022 – Burton Road Bus Stop – Report of anti-social behaviour by playing loud music. Sentinel 132991 created and regular patrols taking place.

14/02/2022 - Criminal Damage to 2 kitchen windows by unknown persons throwing a brick through them. CCTV retrieved, however no identifying features.

15/05/2022 - Criminal Damage - brick thrown at victim's car boot causing dents and scratches.

17/05/2022 - Inappropriate graffiti on the children's playing area.

17/05/2022 - Report of a male throwing full beer bottles at passing motorists - one bottle almost hitting caller's car & caused another to swerve to avoid being hit. Area search by officers with no trace of male or smashed bottles in the road.

18/05/2022 – unknown persons smashing glass. On arrival no persons were located and no smashed glass could be seen.

26/05/2022 – Measham Leisure Centre – reports of youths on motorbikes – enquiries on-going.

28/05/202 – High Street – Iphone has been stolen.

29/05/2022 – High Street – unknown person has caused criminal damage to property.





MOIRA

02/05/2022 Conkers, Moira. Between 19:00hrs and 07:00hrs 03/05/2022 entry has been gained to the Kiosks. Once entry has been gained there has been an untidy search of both kiosks. Caller was not sure if anything had been taken but if this is the case then it would be Ice creams and soft drinks. Crime reference 22*249315 – No CCTV or witnesses.

13/05/2022 - Conkers - Person reported unknown suspect has stolen their phone from a push chair. The pushchair was left for minute whilst the owner purchased a drink from the shop, when they returned they discovered the phone was missing.

19/05/2022 – Conkers –Three youths enter conkers site and cause damage to outbuilding.

09/05/2022 Mercia Park, Burton Road – Argument between 2 males working on a construction site which escalated into a physical altercation taking place. Both parties claimed that other assaulted them first, however there are no witnesses to this and no CCTV of the incident. Both parties do not wish to make a complaint.
