#YouSaid - What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in **January/February/March 2025**

Vehicle Crime – Theft from vehicles in Measham and Appleby Magna.

You Said: You have raised concerns regarding an increase in vehicle related crime including theft of, and theft from vehicles. This has been most notable within Measham and the surrounding villages.

We will: We are working with specialist teams and partners in neighbouring forces to ensure we have a realistic and targeted patrol plan. We have been conducting patrols with the assistance of response colleagues and continue to pay attention in the areas affected. We have been liaising with local councillor stop discuss CCTV options and have developed a specific way-marker in the area to monitor police presence. We are also continuing to develop the investigations and evidence around those offences reported to us.

Drug Dealing in The Close Albert Village

You said: You have said that there are increased issues surrounding drug dealing and associated ASB in the area.

We will: We have developed a patrol strategy to target and disrupt those causing harm. We will continue to monitor and develop intelligence and will look at enforcement options where able. We will also work with partner agencies to ensure we are working effectively.

Road Safety – Speeding – Moira and surrounding areas

You said: You have reported issues related to vehicles in and around Moira. This includes speeding, inconsiderate parking and use of our road networks.

We will: We have planned targeted speeding operations in the areas most affected. We will work with partners in road safety and will look to educate and take positive action against those found to be driving with disregard for laws and safety.

#WeDid - What we are doing

As per our beat priority regarding theft of and from vehicles in the Measham area, patrols in the area are still taking place, however, we are pleased to report that following a series of thefts from motor vehicles in October last year two men have since been charged in connection with the reports.

School parking patrols took place at Albert Village after numerous complaints from concerned residents. It was pleasing to see the majority of parents parked responsibly with only a couple needing words of advice regarding parking too close to junctions. Our presence was well received by many.

Together with the ASB Officer from North West Leicestershire District Council, a patch walk took place In The Close, Albert Village.

In line with our beat priorities a speeding operation took place on Ashby Road, Measham.

We have responded as and when we receive complaints regarding parking and speeding, dealing with as appropriate.

Meet your Team

- Busy month for community engagements with visits to Oakthorpe Leisure Centre, Moira Furnace and AGE UK.
- Ongoing patrols in areas of concerns to identify those involved and reduce incidents. Some of these areas include Measham, Appleby Magna, Moira, Donisthorpe and Albert Village.

- We have been dealing with local issues such as Anti-social Behaviour and safeguarding vulnerable residents as and when we identify concerns.
- We have also been helping in regard to other issues that come to Police such as neighbour disputes, events that impact and cause community concerns, gaining intelligence regarding criminal activity and addressing community safety concerns.
- In line with our beat priorities speeding operations at various locations will be taking place.
- Visits to local schools to talk to Reception Children as part of the 'people who help us' curriculum. School parking patrols also took place.
